SGVS Action (2019-20) HEALTH Profile**SGVS: Action (2019-20) Sapno ki UdaN**

SGVS organized awareness program by the support of proctor & gamble and Arushi foundation in three blocks 48 villages. The program focused to 3000 adolescents' girls ages of 12 - 19 awareness cleanness and hygienic along with mothers and other female members, improving the quality of cleanness, raising awareness and empowering adeolescents and communities so that they take collective action against unhealthy clothes and using senitory pad.

**Out put**

- *Aware 3000 girls on cleanness ,hygiene best practices, gender equality by health department*
- *Approximately 1500 adolescents girls are using sanitary pad in 3 blocks*
- *1055 women aware on hygiene and sanitation and away from dirty clothes*
- *Distributed sanitary pad to 1500 schools and college girls*
- *Government officials of health department (CMO) addressing to girls and women on health, sanitization and cleanness and hygeine*

SGVS: Action (2019-20) Reproductive Health & Family Planning Program

SGVS has focused on health of mother and baby through Global Health Strategy Program. This program has also helped in the birth of children and in contraception and has proved to reduce malnutrition, reduce household expenses and reduce maternal and child mortality. In the program, the community was informed about the benefits of family planning that the most benefit is the mother's health and she can take care of herself and the child well by keeping a gap of 3-5 years between the two children. Birth control improves the health of the mother due to which the risk of premature birth or other complications is reduced. In such a situation, the mother can return to her old and normal state of health prepared Family planning champion on community level and aware on family planning and his miss rumor through Campaign, community meeting and home visit.
